

FABULOUS A-LEVEL RESULTS AT CHIPPING CAMPDEN SCHOOL

THURSDAY 13th AUGUST 2026

Earlier today, students, parents, and staff at Chipping Campden School came together to celebrate the outstanding A-Level results achieved by the class of 2026.



Close to one in five grades awarded were either an A* or A, with some incredible individual achievements across the full ability range and across all 32 courses - one of the widest course offerings in the local area. Additionally, 23 students successfully completed the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), with almost 3 in 4 students (74%) achieving A* or A grades. The school is also one of the largest providers of Level 3 Mathematical Studies in the South West, with 89 students completing this course alongside their three or four A Levels.

These results have enabled the vast majority of our students to progress to their preferred destination, whether that be university, an apprenticeship or employment. Of the 138 students who applied to university this year, 74% secured the grades necessary to reach their 'firm' choice, with a further 9% offered a place at their 'insurance' choice. More placements are expected throughout the day as students are supported through the clearing process.
